

Kind Words Octopus

You will need:

- Craft Paper
- Scissors
- Markers or Crayons
- Glue or Tape
- Googly eyes (optional)

How to make a Kind Words Octopus:

- 1. Print an Octopus template for each child. The designs print equally well on white or colored paper. Consider printing in a variety of bright colors for added interest.*
- 2. Distribute crayons or markers and let children draw faces on the templates. You may also want to supply googly eyes for gluing.*
- 3. Help children cut along the dotted lines. Ask them to turn the templates over and write kind words on the back of each octopus leg.*

These questions might help:

- *What would you say to someone who feels sad?*
- *What could you say to make friends with a new person?*
- *What could you say to help someone who falls down?*
- *What would you say to give someone a compliment?*
- *What could you say to someone you hurt?*
- *Whats the kindest thing anyone has ever said to you?*



- 4. Glue or tape the TAB into place, as indicated.*
- 5. Use the edge of a ruler to curl the legs.*
